- The importance of talking about the prevention of sexual abuse with children and other adults.
- The signs of sexual abuse so you that you might intervene and respond appropriately.

- 20 percent of child sexual abuse victims are under the age of 8.
- More than 90 percent of abusers are people children know, love and trust.
- Only 1 of 10 children who are abused will tell someone. Most never tell...
